*Prof **T. Pawlikowski** living in Chicago is a Servite priest and Professor of Social Ethics at the Catholic Theological Union and a specialist in Jewish Christian Relations. As member of the Catholic Theological Union since 1968 Pawlikowski was appointed to the United States Holocaust Memorial Council in 1980 by then-President Jimmy Carter. he chaired the Council's Subcommittee on Church Relations and served on its Executive Committee, the Committee on Conscience, and Academic Committee. He has been awarded: the Raoul Wallenberg Humanitarian Award for Distinguished Contributions to Religion, Distinguished Service Award from the American Jewish Committee (Chicago) and Army Cross of Merit for Distinguished Service to the Polish Nation and from the Republic of Poland. He is President Emeritus of the International Council of Christians and Jews
